

## **Co B, 6<sup>th</sup> Regt. Georgia Militia**

### ***Brigade of Phillips - Army of Georgia State Troops***

#### **The Battle at Griswoldville Nov 22 1864**

With Sherman nearing Milledgeville mid November 1864, Union General Kilpatrick was in running fights with Wheeler's Cavalry near Macon, and General Walcutt's brigade was near the village of Griswoldville.

There were 3 brigades of Georgia Militia then in Griswoldville, composed largely of the very young or the very old. Their own commander, General Gustavus W. Smith had been detained at Macon, and they were under the temporary leadership of General Pleasant Phillips. Smith's orders to Phillips had been to avoid any engagement with Union forces.

The Militia had previously had seen some limited action on the battlefields at Atlanta, but were still very green and inexperienced, but anxious to prove their mettle.

The stage was set for one of the most appalling virtual massacres of the Georgia Campaign.

At about 1 p.m., just as the Walcutt's men were finishing their dinner, the Georgia Militia attacked. Moving in three lines across the open field, men shouting, rifles blazing. The troops got to within 50 yards of the Union line before the attack stalled. Most of the survivors moved into a ravine perhaps 100 yards in front of the Union line.

From this shelter, they made at least 3 sallies, perhaps more, into the withering fire from the Union line.

Those of the militia that could, finally withdrew at dusk.

Of approximately 2000 militia that took the field, there were left only about 600, while Walcutt lost fewer than 100 men.

**Davis, James M.**-Private May 18 1861. Absent without leave Feb 1862. Wounded through left arm and disabled July 2 1863 at Gettysburg, and captured there July 6 1863. Imprisoned there in Letterman General Hospital and at West's Building Hospital Baltimore Md. Sent to City Point Va for exchange Nov 17 1863. Retired to Invalid Corps, P.A.C.S. Aug 2 1864. Captured in Forsyth County Ga in 1864. Imprisoned at Military Prison at Louisville Ky where he took oath of allegiance to the U.S. Govt Oct 10 1864, and was released to remain north of Ohio River during war. Name appears on roll of Retired men at the Post of Columbus Ga dated Dec 3 1864, which does not show him absent. Return of that Post for Feb 1865 shows him "casually" at Post. No later record. Died Nov 27 1907.

**Hanks, John T.**-Private May 18 1861. Wounded in foot and disabled at Sharpsburg Md Sept 17 1862. Died from wounds at Lavinia Groves Farm Md hospital, date not known.

**Hardison, C.C.**-Private May 18 1861. Captured at Sharpsburg Md Sept 17 1862. Received at City Point Va for exchange Dec 4 1862. No later record.

**Harp, A.J.**-Private May 18 1861. Appears last on roll for June 30 1861.

**Harvey, B.G.**-Private. Died of pneumonia in General Hospital at Camp Wilder near Richmond Va Oct 7 1862. Buried there in Hollywood Cemetery.

**Henry, B.C.**-Private May 18 1861. Received pay at Richmond Va June 20 1862. No later report.

**Herndon, J.C.**-Private May 18 1861. Elected 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. May 6 1864. Surrendered Tallahassee Fal May 10 1865. Paroled at Albany Ga May 17 1865.

**Hill, John S.**-Private May 18 1861. Captured at Sailor's Creek Va Apr 6 1865. Released at Pt Lookout Md June 28 1865.

**Hollis, J.H.**-Private May 18 1861. Appointed 4<sup>th</sup> Sergt. Sept 11 1865. Wounded date and place not given. On wounded furlough Feb 28 1865. No later record.

**Holt, C.C.**-Private May 20 1861. Detailed with Division Signal Corps Jan 1865. Absent without leave Feb 9-28 1865. No later record.

**Howard, Charles Nelson, Sr.**-Private May 18 1861. Discharged on disability Dec 14 1861. Appointed 5<sup>th</sup> Sergt. Of Co B, 3<sup>rd</sup> Regt Ga Cavalry Apr 17 1862. Roll for Dec 31 1864, last on file, shows him present. Pension records show he surrendered Apr 26 1865 at Greensboro, N.C. (Resident of Ga since 1845.)

**Jenkins, Thomas L.**-Private May 18 1861. Deserted. In U.S.A. Military (Libby) Prison at Richmond Va Apr 10 1865.

**Johnson, William S.**-Private May 18 1861. Captured, date and place not given. A paroled prisoner of war Sept 27 1862. No later record.

**Jones, J.T.**-Private May 18 1861. Surrendered May 10 1865 at Tallahassee Fla. Paroled Quincy Fla May 24 1865.

**LaHatte, Albert H.**-Private May 18 1861. In Columbus Ga hospital Feb 28 1865. No later record.

**Langford, John J.**-Private May 18 1861. Elected 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. Sept 17 1862. Killed at Wilderness Va May 6 1864.

**Lunsford, H.D.**-Private Jan 26 1864. Killed at Cedar Creek Va Oct 19 1864.
