Although some generic subject headings are used, most headings relate to aspects of Columbus, Georgia history and genealogy. Articles treating non-Columbus locales are indexed under the geographic name of the locale. There are no cross-listings; an article is listed only once — under the main subject that it treats. Under each heading, articles are listed in chronological order by publication date.

Please note that in addition to the personal name index in the back of each issue of *Muscogiana*, a cumulative personal name index for all issues published to date is available at Columbus State University archives, Genealogy Room the main branch of the Columbus Public Library and online. This cumulative index is updated after each new edition is published.
