BRYAN/BRYANT, Needham

Administrator Bonds Book D 1838-1880

P. 43. 12 Jan 1846.

Joseph Brunson & Thomas Brunson bond for Joseph to be guardian of Martha Ann BRYAN, orphan of Needham BRYAN, dec'd.

P. 44 12 Jan 1837

Archibald Bonnell & George W. Carriker bond for Archibald Bonnell to be guardian of Julia Ann BRYAN, orphan of Needham Bryan, dec'd.

Minute Book 1838-1861 P. 10 Jan 1839

Martha B. Bryant, Adm. of Needham Bryan, dec'd now Martha B. Ruffin has committed waste and removed without the limits of Georgia. Uriah Helms and Fielding Sharp released from sureties.

Columbus Enquirer 9 April 1845.

Muscogee County, Ga: Thirty days after date, we shall make application to the Court of Ordinary of said county at the first court after the expiration of said time, for leave to sell all the real estate of Needham Bryan, late of said county, deceased, for the purpose of paying the debts of said estate and for distribution. Signed Archibald Bonnell, Administrator.

Letters of Administration Book D 1838-1880 P. 33. 12 Jan 1846

Archibald Bonnell and George W. Carriker bound unto Justices of Inferior Court, \$2000 bond for said Archibald Bonnell's guardianship of Julia Ann Bryan, an orphan of Needham Bryan, dec'd. Signed Archibald Bonnell, George W. Cariker.

Columbus Enquirer 17 Sep 1845.

Muscogee Co., Ga: Pursuant to an order from the Court of Ordinary of said county, will be sold on the first Tuesday in December next, at the court house door at Columbus, in said county, within the legal hours of sale, the following described property: 440A on the Chattahoochee River, adjoining H. C. Sapp... sold as the property of Needham Bryan, deceased, for the benefit of the heirs and creditors of said deceased. Terms cash. Signed Archibald Bonnell, Administrator.
