

1832 Creek Indian Census

Lower Towns

Colonial Indian agents used the terms "Upper Creek" and "Lower Creek" to refer to the two Tribal Divisions. So, the 1832 Census refers to the Upper Towns and the Lower Towns. The Upper Creeks lived on the Coosa and Tallapoosa Rivers in Alabama. The Lower Creeks lived on the Chattahoochee and Flint Rivers near the present Alabama-Georgia borders.

Many of the dislocated tribes can be found among the Creek Confederacy.

Land Deeds in Russell County, Alabama show the sale of many of the Creek Indians to the whites. Some of their wills can be found there as well. The Russell County, AL Court House is located in Phenix City, AL.
