Today in Columbus History: On Thursday, May 3, 1877, the City Light Guards had an advertisement in the "Columbus Daily Times." They were sponsoring a dance: a Hop! It was going to be at the City Armory that night and tickets were 50 cents – for men. The ladies got in free!
